## Timeline for the Fall



- 1. Carefully review your transcript
- 2. Discuss letters of recommendation with teachers and provide what they need
- 3. Decide if you will take any standardized tests in the fall: ACT -10/26; 12/14; SAT & SAT Subject Tests 10/5, 11/2, 12/7
- 4. Athletes: Register with the NCAA at EligibilityCenter.org

- 5. Research colleges: on your own; visits at school; college fairs-ours is 10/21; college websites
- 6. Settle on a list of colleges and enter into Naviance, Common Application and other apps
- 7. Review deadlines, requirements for each application; begin to work on submissions
- 8. Consider meeting with your counselor/college access counselor at each school



# Types of Admission



## Non-Restrictive

- Rolling Admission
- Regular Decision
- Early Action (EA)

## Restrictive

- Restrictive Early Action (REA)

  Only early application!
- Early Decision (ED)
- Early Decision II

  Must attend if accepted!

## **Deadlines**

- None (apply early!)
  - ~ Jan. 1/15
  - ~ Nov. 1/15

- ~ Nov. 1/15
- ~ Nov. 1/15
- ~ Jan. 15/Feb.1

# NACAC Definitions of Admission Options

### STUDENTS: WHICH COLLEGE ADMISSION PROCESS BEST SUITS YOU?

#### **Regular Decision**

#### **DEFINITION:**

Students submit an application by a specified date and receive a decision in a clearly stated period of time.

#### COMMITMENT:

**NON-BINDING** 

#### Rolling Admission

#### **DEFINITION:**

Institutions review applications as they are submitted and render admission decisions throughout the admission cycle.

#### COMMITMENT:

**NON-BINDING** 

#### Early Action (EA)

#### **DEFINITION:**

Students apply early and receive a decision well in advance of the institution's regular response date.

#### COMMITMENT:

**NON-BINDING** 

Students are not restricted from applying to other institutions and have until May 1 to consider their options and confirm enrollment.

#### Early Decision (ED)

#### **DEFINITION:**

Students make a commitment to a first-choice institution where, if admitted they definitely will enroll and withdraw all other applications. The application deadline and decision deadline occur early.

#### COMMITMENT:

BINDING

#### Restrictive Early Action (REA)

#### **DEFINITION:**

Students apply to an institution of preference and receive a decision early. They may be restricted from applying ED or EA or REA to other institutions. If offered enrollment, they have until May 1 to confirm.

#### COMMITMENT:

**NON-BINDING** 

Students are responsible for determining and following restrictions.

Both EDI & II are binding



# **Application Components**



#### **Counselor**

Submits counselor recommendation; provides school profile; advises student as needed

### Registrar

Submits transcripts and grade reports

### College Board or ACT

Submits test scores

### **STUDENT**

Sets up list of colleges in Naviance; requests transcripts and grade reports; requests letters of recommendation-all applications in Naviance; requests test scores.

Completes Common App and/ or other application forms and FERPA release


### **Teachers**

Mail or upload letter of recommendation

- All students will use Naviance Student
  - Student.naviance.com/harriton or /lowermerion
  - Central clearinghouse for processing applications, transcripts, more
- Over 850 colleges of the almost 4,000 in the US and abroad use The Common Application
- The majority of colleges accept school documents & letters electronically; a few, usually international universities, want documents mailed
- The Coalition Application, applies to 140 colleges; Some colleges such as the U of MD are Coalition exclusive. Many of the colleges on Coalition App are on The Common Application too
- Some universities have their own process-Penn State, Pitt, Rutgers and other universities use a self-reported process, which means you input your own courses and grades and either use The Common App,their online app or the Coalition App
- Each process is defined on Naviance, which is a great source of information
- Deadlines are very important in the college process to keep on track!

# A Change in Financial Aid Timing

- Families will be able to file for aid through the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) beginning October 1!
- Families will be able to use their prior-prior year tax information, aka PPY, when reporting personal and family income
- Example-Since student will enter college in the fall of 2020, you will use your 2018 tax information-a huge change from waiting to get taxes done in January and racing against February deadlines
