Your **personal contact information stays private**, and you can access your full message history at any time.

Remind is **free to use** for educators, students, and parents.



Four ways to fill your Remind class

- Participants can **text your class code to 81010** from any phone, including flip phones—exactly the way we just saw.
- Participants can **download the app** at rmd.me, click on "Join a Class," and enter your class code.
- Send invitations directly to phone numbers or email addresses. You can even copy and paste information from a spreadsheet!
- Participants can go to <u>remind.com/join</u> on the web and enter your class code.




Messaging you can control

TIP


Use 5 minutes of your planning period to schedule assignment reminders for the month ahead.


Translate

Participants using the app on a phone set in a different language will get the option of translating your messages.






Add attachments

TIP


Instead of printing handouts, send them to students via Remind as PDFs.

 Send messages about assignments, events, and activities—or just a quick word of encouragement to keep participants engaged.
